All our display is highly educational, some giving a poignant; insight, such as the risks Secret Agent and RAF support crews took during the war. There are hands on experiences, such Morse Code, controlling trains and cars and other activities for the younger generation. For the adults, a wide selection of A4 display panels give easy to read facts about all aspect of each topic, Most of the displays are backed up by our website.

The display is usually housed in a commercial grade 3m gazebo, with power being drawn from batteries.. At some events I also use a classic car as transport, which can also form part of the display.

Last years range of exhibits, proved popular with few quite moments.

We carry Public liability insurance of 5 million, due to the rare nature of some of the display items; we need to remove them overnight on multi day events, so access will be required to the site at start and finish.

Please note: our displays emit noise, Morse code, Royalty free Period Recordings, Music and Poetry. We do not retail or sell any products at events, but may give out display related third party flyer etc.
