

B2 SPY SET

Or more correctly named MK3 TYPE2 This was the main clandestine radio set used during WW11 It produced a hefty 20Watts of Transmitting Power It was widely used by the resistance and special agents, SOE The case contained spare valves, aerial wire, and instructions Communications was by Morse only, on the Short Wave Band Often operated from restricted locations eg : cellars Contacts could be made for several 100 miles A crystal fixed the transmitter frequency Fixing the frequency, guaranteed that the agent was monitored 24/7 The receiver was tuneable for normal broadcast stations Cryptic messages were sent in between the radio programs These were in code and gave the clandestine operator instructions "The Geese have laid two eggs" Could mean an attack in two days time at a certain place This system worked well during the war Clandestine workers played a vital part in winning the war In the late 50's the B2 was eagerly bought by Radio Hams Even today it is the most priced of WW2 Radio's
