

PARASET (Whaddon Mark V11)



The Paraset was one of the first successful miniaturized radio sets
Designed for the Britain's Special Operations Executive, which
conducted espionage and other activities behind German lines,

Developed at the Royal Signals Special Communications Unit
workshops at Whaddon Hall Buckinghamshire in the early stages
of World War II. The equipment is known as the "Paraset" because
it was dropped by parachute for field agents

Morse (CW) only

Receiver tuned from 3 -7.6 MHz

Transmitter fixed by crystal

Transmit Power 4 Watts

Range up to 1000 miles
