

RBZ Special SPY RESISTANCE RECIEVER

The original receiver was designed for the US landings on D Day. This modified version was dropped to resistance workers, to monitor coded instruction, broadcast by the BBC on the Short Wave Band. The receiver is beautifully built and operates with small 5 valves. It could be warn in a clandestine fashion as, the British MRC1 But being caught with one would have meant certain death

A typical BBC cryptic message:

Suzette has hung her washing out to dry the operation will take place Saturday There are red flowers in the forest the drop will be made tomorrow night.

At one point during the war, BBC announcers went on strike about having to continually sent such messages,

They felt that the message were to frequent and the nonsensical nature was lowering the tone of broadcasting standards.
