Formed on the 13 June 1940 by Winston Church. The original HQ was at 64 Baker street, a top secrete address, code names MO1, NID(Q) and A10 Its activities initially focused on Propaganda, Operations and research. The Bond style Research Dept, was known as "Churchill's Toy Shop" Under the control of Sir Frank Nelson, the aim of SOE was to spread widespread Civil disobedience, nuisance and sabotage in axis countries As the SOE developed, the aims of the organising turned more to supporting the intended Allied invasion, providing advanced intelligence and creating a secrete army, ready to rise up when the invasion occurred. Training and selection were demanding, carried out all over the country, manly in remote stately homes, SOE Known as "Statley Omes of England" MD1 nr Aylesbury Weapons training, X11 nr Stevenage Explosives, ISRB nr Welwyn Radio, Weapons, Explosives and Bobbie traps, XV Boarhamwood Camouflage, Hiding weapons, Explosives, Local dress, Money, Personal effects and Documents. Raf Rimney Security, Warnbrough Commando training, Aslisaif Scotland Unarmed combat, Altringham Parachute training, Beaulieu Tradecraft. Equipment Developed for use By SOE included: The Welrod, silent assassins gun, Fairburn and Sykes fighting Knife Suicide pills, Plastic explosives, Limpet mines, Time pencils Camouflaged explosives, such as coal to put in train coal bunkers, Spikes, to put under car tyres, Trip lines, Contaminants for fuel tanks. Clandestine Radios, Miniature telescopes, Silk maps etc. The SOE were deployed and supported, by two secrete RAF squadrons operating from RAF Tempsford. 161 Squadron flew Lysanders deploying key personnel and 138 Squadron flew modified bombers dropping supplies, in cylindrical 1.8m 102kg containers, also agents by parachute.
