

UHER 4000 Report

High Quality Cold War Tape Recorder

Introduced in 1961, it was widely used by the secrete service.

Used for recording enemy radio communications, which were out of range, of listening stations, such as GCHQ.

The 4000 could also be used, for telephone line tapping or covertly recording of conversations, with hidden or long range microphones.

The UHER was heavy, weighing over 3Kg, so it was usually hidden in a strong brief case, which would not have aroused suspicion at the time, as every businessman had one.

The **UHER Report 4000** was very popular with news reporters, such as the BBC. The tape could run, at a whopping 19 cm per second, which gave suburb audio quality for broadcast.
